Definition

- **Sedqa** from the Maltese verb **SeDDaQ** which means to put something upright
- The data presented here is not desegregated by gender.
 However, we should not treat the population of substance
 misusers as a homogenous group as research conducted for
 the Pompidou Group and published in April 2015 (Prof.
 Marilyn Clark UOM) shows that there are wide variances
 between the sexes and ages of the drug using population.
- "... gender is not predictive in the same direction across drug categories. It highlight how the telescoping phenomenon is evident for women in their NMUPD 'career path' and that they manifest different patterns of use to men. ..."



Our Partners

- Sedqa is not alone in combatting substance misue in Malta.






Approximate total number of cases worked with between January and December 2014 at sedqa by district of residence






The approximate rate per 1,000 person of cases worked in Agenzija Sedqa between January and December 2014 by town of residence




The approximate total number of cases worked with at Sedqa between January and December 2014 by town of residence
















Total number of talks, participants and materials distributed by the Primary Prevention Team
