**WeFree Days** is a two-day event, which provides a space for dialogue, sharing best practices among representatives of international and national institutions, public and private sector, not-for-profit-institutions, students, partners of WeFree, the youth prevention project created and implemented by San Patrignano.

**The themes of the two days are related to drug addiction and youth social exclusion.** The first day will promote a challenging debate on the role played by therapeutic communities facing the so called “normalisation of drugs”.

The second day will focus on the prevention model, presenting the peer to peer approach and measuring its impact.
